

## Seven Mills Primary School: School Performance Tables 2016 – 17

We assess pupils' progress carefully throughout their time at school, and use these assessments to plan what the children need to be learning next.

Pupils are assessed at three key points during their primary schooling: end of Year R; end of Year 2 and end of Year 6. (The end of each key stage.) This data is passed to the Borough and central government.

The tables below shows pupils' performance at the end of Key Stage 2 (Year 6) in 2017. We also show the provisional national mean averages data for comparison purposes.
